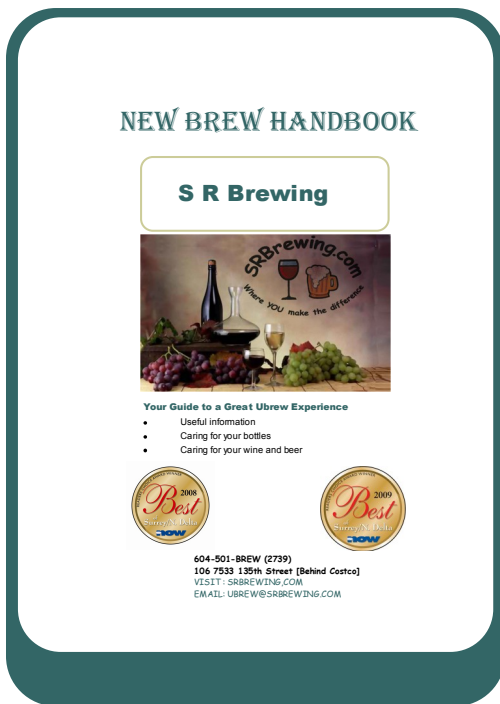

The brew charge includes rental of all necessary equipment until I bottle. I authorize the operator to hold this product until I return to bottle and take home my wine or beer. I will abide by the Ubrew rules and sample no more than 3 oz while I bottle.
